The City of Euless will be holding two City Council candidate elections simultaneously on Saturday, May 11, 2013. The General Election for Place One and Place Three will be held to elect Council Members for three-year terms. A Special Election will be held to elect a Council Member for the unexpired one-year term in Place Four.

The Filing Period for Place 1 & 3 will take place Jan. 30 - March 1.
The Filing Period for Place 4 will take place Feb. 9 - March 11.

The General Election and the Special Election will take place together. Early voting begins April 29. Election Day is on May 11.
