Averting Stage Two Watering Restrictions Not Likely

Severe to extreme drought conditions have been present in North Texas for the past four years. The lakes that Tarrant County utilizes for water storage reservoirs are Lake Bridgeport, Cedar Creek, Eagle Mountain and Richland-Chambers. The combined lake levels determine the observed stages of the drought contingency plan. At the time of this writing, the storage capacity is 61.5%. Once these lakes drop below 60% of capacity, Tarrant County will begin observing Stage Two Drought Restrictions. This next set of restrictions dictate that watering take place only once a week.

Stage Two is a sign of more dire circumstances. During this stage water users are limited to watering once a week and are prohibited from using water for dust control, operation of ornamental fountains or ponds (except where necessary to support aquatic life) and are encouraged to wait to establish new landscaping. A watering schedule will be determined and neighborhoods will be informed of their watering schedule by Eules Today newsletter, signs, email and the Eules web site.

Please continue to conserve water and limit outdoor irrigation, especially during the winter when lawns are dormant. Save water. Nothing can replace it.


