Dear Mr. McCurley:

This is in response to your relocation application concerning the proposed construction of one of the above listed concrete batch plants (LHL Plant 11-014 or 11-018) to be located approximately 700 feet south of East Midway Drive, and 150 feet west of Bear Creek Parkway, in Euless, Tarrant County, Texas. Based on the information presented, the TCEQ DFW Regional Office Air Program has determined that the proposed construction can be granted to construct and operate one of the above referenced facilities at the proposed site, since it is located in or contiguous to the right-of-way of a public works project. The TCEQ DFW Regional Office understands that LH Lacy Company only intends to locate one of the above referenced concrete batch plants at the site, but is unable to determine which plant at this time.

We understand that you intend to construct one of the above referenced facilities on or about July 29, 2013, to begin operations on or about the same day, and remain at this site until the completion of the project. This authorization is contingent upon continued compliance with the conditions listed in the applicable NSR Permit (Permit No. 53037 or No. 81944) for the plant and all subsequent representations made in your relocation request. Any changes to the representations must have prior written approval from a delegated representative of the executive director. After completion of construction or modification, start-up notification is required in accordance with 30 TAC 116.115(b)(2)(B)(i). This facility shall be operated in compliance with all conditions of the applicable NSR Permit (Permit No. 53037 or No. 81944). Enclosed is a notification form for you to complete and send in prior to your construction or site move, to inform the TCEQ of which one of the above referenced concrete batch plants will be moving to the proposed location.
