**SUMMARY OF SUBJECT:**

City Council previously adopted regulations requiring convenience stores and check cashing businesses to have surveillance camera systems to aid in prosecution of crimes. In order to properly utilize surveillance camera systems in connection with the detection and prosecution of crime, all systems installed from this point forward are required to be MP4 compatible. This requirement is driven by recent court rulings and the evidence processing requirements of the Tarrant County District Attorney.
